1 Monday

Pray for all the women who received Mothers' Day cards from their children in prison this past Sunday. May they know God's comfort throughout the separation, and may God bring healing and reconciliation where it is needed.

6 Saturday

Thank God for all the Angel Tree Coordinators who have worked hard the last few months to organise the Mothers' Day cards from young offenders.

7 Sunday

On World Health Day, we pray for men and women in prison struggling with illness, that they might quickly receive the treatment and support they need, and know God's comfort and peace.

8 Monday

Last month, a new estimate of the number of children with a parent in prison was released. Pray for the 312,000 children who are missing their mum or dad today. Pray that there would be improved and joined-up support from government services for these children who are often invisible in the system.

9 Tuesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course beginning at HMP/YOI Rochester.

10 Wednesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course finishing at HMP Springhill.

11 Thursday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course finishing at HMP Berwyn.

12 Friday

Pray for our letter writers this month, that those in prison who are struggling to know what to write will find the courage and inspiration to put pen to paper.

13 Saturday

Thank God for the chaplains who will be journeying with the men and women in their prison through Holy Week, and sharing its message of hope.

May God give them fresh energy and joy as they serve this week.

14 Palm Sunday

This Sunday, we remember that Jesus came in humility, riding on a donkey. May we seek to have that same humility in our ministry.

15 Monday

As we remember the day Jesus cleansed the Temple, we pray that our churches might be places of radical welcome to all, particularly to men and women who have been in prison.

There are *Sycamore Tree* courses ending at HMP Brixton and HMP Onley.

16 Tuesday

During Holy Week, Jesus preached the parable of the sheep and the goats – may we always remember that when we visit men and women in prison, Jesus said we are visiting Him.

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course finishing at HMP/YOI Downview, and one beginning at HMP Stocken.

Our Area Leaders are meeting in London today – pray their time would be fruitful.

17 Wednesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course beginning at HMP Whitemoor.

The *Sycamore Tree* steering group is meeting today. Pray for wisdom and insight as they gather.

18 Thursday

Jesus washed his disciples' feet as an act of service, and said they were to do likewise. We pray that our motivation to serve in prison would always be rooted in love.

19 Good Friday

Today, we remember Jesus' death for us, and we thank God that His love reaches out to all – even those who have been written off by society, like the criminal who hung next to Jesus.

20 Saturday

Today, pray for those known to you in prison who are struggling in darkness – with mental health, thoughts of suicide, bereavement and grief. We pray they would come to know that God is with them in their despair, and can bring hope and peace.

21 Easter Sunday

Alleluia! Praise God for this gift of love and grace, that through Jesus' resurrection we have the

promise of life eternal!

22 Monday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course finishing at HMYOI Wetherby.

23 Tuesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course finishing at HMP & YOI Bedford.

24 Wednesday

The PF Board of Trustees have their annual away days today and tomorrow. Ask that God would bring them together in friendship and service, for the benefit of the whole organisation.

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course beginning at HMP & YOI Hollesley Bay.

25 Thursday

There are two *Sycamore Tree* courses starting today at HMP Ford and HMP/YOI Isis.

26 Friday

Pray for the Probation system, which is struggling to keep up with the demand placed on it. Pray that those in leadership might have wisdom to know how to improve the service, and support men and women on their release.
