3 Saturday We are awaiting decisions from a number of trusts and foundations to whom we have applied for funding. Pray for all learners graduating this month, that what they have experienced will give them strength and wisdom on the journey ahead.
4 Sunday – Prayer Wall “My prayer for those working in prison chaplaincy is that Lord, you would give them great wisdom, patience and compassion in their work in prisons so they can show your love to the men and women they serve and work alongside.”	13 Tuesday The PF Trustees are meeting today to discuss young people in prison. Thank God for the time and skill they bring to their role, and pray for a positive and fruitful meeting.
5 Monday Today is the first day of PF's annual financial audit. Thank God for our finance team and do pray for Ian and Liliana while the audit takes place.	14 Wednesday We pray for children with a parent in prison during the summer school holidays, that they might receive the support they need, and their relationship with their parent would be strengthened despite the distance.
6 Tuesday It's the final day of our audit. Thank God for the incredible generosity of every individual, church and organisation that financially supports PF.	15 Thursday We pray for prison staff who are new in their job, that they will find the support from experienced colleagues to grow in their role and provide the best possible care to those in their establishment.
7 Wednesday – Prayer Line request K asks for prayers for himself and his family that they find peace and happiness. He also asks for prayer for a friend and her daughter that they find what they are looking for.	16 Friday – Prayer Line request J asks for prayers for our Heavenly Father to bring light into individuals' lives in his prison.
8 Thursday Pray that as an organisation, we would embody our value of hope and show that every life can be transformed.	17 Saturday As we explore 'Sheep without a shepherd' in this week's Bible Study, we thank God for the example of Jesus.
9 Friday This week's Bible Study is exploring the great shepherd. Pray that we would all choose to follow the way of Christ more every day.

23	Friday – Prayer Wall “My prayer for those working in prison is that they will be strengthened, have great wisdom, and peace in every circumstance.”	30	Friday Today is the International Day of Friendship. We thank God for the friendships that are being built between our volunteer letter writers and those in prison, and that these friendships might help “carry each other’s burdens” (Galatians 6:2).
