1 Wednesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course ending today at HMP Swaleside.

2 Thursday

Our Angel Tree appeal began this week. Thank God for each person who has generously donated so far and pray that we will reach our matched funding target.

3 Friday

Give thanks for each of our Letter Link volunteers. Correspondence with people in prison is particularly crucial at this time of year.

4 Saturday

Our Bible Study reminds us that God will finish what He has started. Pray that everyone in prison would be encouraged to continue on their journeys.

5 Sunday

On this second Sunday in Advent, we pray for peace to be present in every prison. May all violence and conflict cease, and may God's security be very present.

6 Monday

There are three *Sycamore Tree* courses ending today at HMP Altcourse, HMP Lewes, and HMP Pentonville.

7 Tuesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course ending today at HMP Humber.

8 Wednesday – *Prayer Line* request

S asks for prayer for a fellow attendee of an Alpha course whose mother had been attacked. He also asks for God's help as he comes off methadone.

9 Thursday

There are two *Sycamore Tree* courses ending today at HMP Risley and HMP Thorn Cross.

10 Friday

Pray for Angel Tree Co-ordinators who are finalising preparations for this year's programme. Ask God to be with them especially if they are feeling stressed or overwhelmed.

11 Saturday

As this week's Bible Study encourages us to give thanks, take a moment to thank God for all the good things in your life.

12 Sunday

On this third Sunday in Advent, we pray for joy to be the surprising gift of this season - that moments of joy would break through despite the challenges and pain of prison life.

13 Monday

Many prisons will be hosting Carol Services this week. Pray that they will be a blessing to all who attend.

14 Tuesday – Prayer Line request

B asks for prayer as he is really struggling since his fiancée passed away a few months ago.

15 Wednesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course ending today at HMP Winchester.

16 Thursday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course ending today at HMP Berwyn.

17 Friday

With Sycamore Tree courses completed until the New Year, please pray that all of our volunteers will rest well over the Christmas period.

18 Saturday

As we explore God's promises in this week's Bible Study, pray everyone in prison would know God's love, compassion and strength.

19 Sunday

On this fourth Sunday in Advent, we pray for God's love to surround everyone who lives and works in prison. Ask that they will know they are deeply valued and cared for.

20 Monday

Praise God for the incredible efforts of our Angel Tree volunteers who have helped ensure that over 4,000 children will receive a gift from their parent in prison this Christmas.

21 Tuesday – Prayer Line request

J asks for prayer for guidance when he is released from prison to meet the right people and make the right choices.

22 Wednesday

As the days get lighter, we ask that God would draw close to people in prison who are experiencing seasonal depression.

23 Thursday

Thank God for the Prayer Line Administrators working throughout the Christmas period to ensure prisoners' prayers are distributed.

24 Friday – Christmas Eve

Today, we think of the many thousands of children with a parent in prison, who will be missing them tonight, or struggling with the hurt of their absence. We pray they would experience God's comfort and love this night, and that tomorrow would bring joy and hope.

25 Saturday – Christmas Day

God with us, we thank and praise You for the precious gift of Yourself. Thank You for being born into our lives, for bringing us Your peace and hope. Thank You that You continue to be present in the darkest places. We pray for every weary person in prison, that they will recognise Your presence with them today.

26 Sunday – Boxing Day

Pray for everyone in prison engaging with this week's Bible Study based on Luke 2:8-20. May it be a light to their feet and bring hope to all who read it.

27 Monday

Thank God for our Support Team and pray that they are all resting well over the Christmas break.

28 Tuesday – Prayer Line request

S asks for prayer for all those feeling suicidal and for himself as he is feeling overwhelmed by his trial and jury verdict.

29 Wednesday

We pray for all the chaplains and prison staff working over Christmas and thank God for their service.

30 Thursday

Thank God for all Chaplaincy Support volunteers, many of whom have been working over Christmas assisting chaplaincy teams in their ministry.

31 Friday – New Year's Eve

At the end of the year, we give thanks for God's faithfulness and loving kindness, for sustaining and strengthening us throughout the year, and for God's grace, which is offered freely to us all.
