5	Sunday On this second Sunday in Advent, we pray for peace to be present in every prison. May all violence and conflict cease, and may God's security be very present.	15	Wednesday There is a <i>Sycamore Tree</i> course ending today at HMP Winchester.
6	Monday There are three <i>Sycamore Tree</i> courses ending today at HMP Altcourse, HMP Lewes, and HMP Pentonville.	16	Thursday There is a <i>Sycamore Tree</i> course ending today at HMP Berwyn.
7	Tuesday There is a <i>Sycamore Tree</i> course ending today at HMP Humber.	17	Friday With <i>Sycamore Tree</i> courses completed until the New Year, please pray that all of our volunteers will rest well over the Christmas period.
8	Wednesday – Prayer Line request S asks for prayer for a fellow attendee of an Alpha course whose mother had been attacked. He also asks for God's help as he comes off methadone.	18	Saturday As we explore God's promises in this week's Bible Study, pray everyone in prison would know God's love, compassion and strength.
9	Thursday There are two <i>Sycamore Tree</i> courses ending today at HMP Risley and HMP Thorn Cross.	19	Sunday On this fourth Sunday in Advent, we pray for God's love to surround everyone who lives and works in prison. Ask that they will know they are deeply valued and cared for.
10	Friday Pray for Angel Tree Co-ordinators who are finalising preparations for this year's programme. Ask God to be with them especially if they are feeling stressed or overwhelmed.	20	Monday Praise God for the incredible efforts of our <i>Angel Tree</i> volunteers who have helped ensure that over 4,000 children will receive a gift from their parent in prison this Christmas.
