3	Thursday Thank God for the work of Prison Radio, informing and connecting prisoners with opportunities to grow and change.	7 Monday Our <i>Sycamore Tree</i> tutors meet for their monthly discussion today. Pray that they would have a positive time together. The second part of the <i>Sycamore Tree</i> Group Facilitator training also takes place today. Pray for a fruitful session.

Pray for all those who will be arriving at the prison, that they would quickly be able to settle into their new location.	8 Tuesday – Prayer Line request C calls with the news that, after requesting prayer last week, his dad has made a miraculous recovery and wants to thank God.
5	Saturday Today is the first part of training for new <i>Sycamore Tree</i> group facilitators. Thank God for their willingness and enthusiasm to be part of this work and pray that they will be equipped and empowered to lead well and see lives changed. There is a <i>Sycamore Tree</i> course scheduled to start today at HMP Ford.	9 Wednesday During Children's Mental Health Week, we pray for children who have a parent in prison and thank God for the relationships restored through <i>Angel Tree</i> this Christmas and how impactful these connections can be for children's mental health.
6	Sunday	10 Thursday The Bible Studies Steering Group is meeting today. Thank God for their commitment to bring Bible Studies to people in

	prison, particularly in a time when many chapels are closed.		
11	Friday There is a <i>Letter Link</i> training taking place today. Thank God for the friendship and dedication that our letter writers offer their pen-pals in prison. May it be a true consolation in a difficult time.	18	Friday – Prayer Line request P asks God to help improve communication with his probation officer and help them to see the progress he is making.
12	Saturday Pray for everyone in prison reading this week’s Bible Study on Jeremiah 17, that they would choose to trust in God, and He would give them a new heart.	19	Saturday Loving our enemies is incredibly challenging. Pray that this week’s Bible Study from Luke 6:27-36 would help people in prison follow the way of Jesus.
13	Sunday Pray that more people in prison would hear about our <i>Letter Link</i> programme and sign up to be involved. Thank God for the many volunteers training recently to be letter writers.	20	Sunday Thank God for the hundreds of people that pray diligently for Prison Fellowship every day, for this network of hearts attuned to God’s heart for justice and mercy.
