<b>1 Monday</b> At the beginning of the working week, we pray for everyone caring for people in prison – for governors, chaplains, healthcare workers, prison officers and the many others who work in our prisons.	<b>10 Wednesday</b> Today we are running a <i>Letter Link</i> training session. Pray for Tim and Stephen as they run the session and everyone attending.  There is a <i>Sycamore Tree</i> course ending at HMP Wayland today.
<b>2 Tuesday</b> There is a <i>Sycamore Tree</i> course starting today at HMP Onley.	<b>11 Thursday</b> As our latest appeal begins to hit doormats, we pray it would resonate with people and encourage all who read it.
<b>3 Wednesday – Prayer Line request</b> D is due for a court appearance soon, so asks for prayer to receive a sentence he can cope with as he’s experiencing a lot of anxiety about it.	<b>12 Friday</b> We pray for Bob Wilson and the <i>Prisons Week</i> team as they prepare for this year’s event. We ask that God would use it to raise further awareness of people in prison and the amazing work done by all the <i>Prisons Week</i> partner organisations.
<b>4 Thursday</b> We pray for everyone who came along to our <i>Exploring Prison Ministry</i> event last month – may God continue to grow their heart for people in prison and provide opportunities to serve Him in prison.	<b>13 Saturday – Bible Study</b> The <i>Bible Study</i> this week is entitled “Keep going.” It encourages us to persevere in our faith. Ask God to move any obstacles that people in prison are facing in their faith journey.
<b>5 Friday</b> Please continue to pray for our new Chair, Peter Harlock, as he settles into his role and builds relationships with trustees, volunteers and support team.	<b>14 Sunday</b> As many of us worship in churches throughout England and Wales, let us take a moment to remember our brothers and sisters in Christ who are in prison.
<b>6 Saturday – Bible Study</b> This week’s <i>Bible Study</i> is from Luke 12 and invites people in prison to bring the Kingdom of God into their daily lives. Pray that this message would uplift and guide people in prison today.	<b>15 Monday</b> Thank God for the incredible work of <a href="#">Signpost</a> which has created an online database of thousands of organisations available to support people coming out of prison.
<b>7 Sunday</b> We pray for everyone attending chapel today, and particularly for those who are still unable to attend chapel or other groups due to current prison restrictions.	<b>16 Tuesday – Prayer Line request</b> K asks for prayer for her son who is currently in another country. She is desperate to make contact with him.
<b>8 Monday</b> Thank God for our amazing patrons, Bishop Rachel Treweek and Rev Jonathan Aitken. We pray for their continued good health and blessings upon their ministries.	<b>17 Wednesday</b> We pray for everyone in prison who is in education and training for a qualification. As they study, we pray the right opportunities would open up for them.
<b>9 Tuesday – Prayer Line request</b> S prays that he and his girlfriend can get through their current difficulties and their relationship can be strengthened.
