28 Monday

Lift up to God everyone in prison who do not receive visits or contact from people outside. Pray they make positive

- connections in prison and find the support and care they need.

30 Wednesday

31 Thursday

We pray for everyone in prison who is experiencing loneliness today. May they know God's presence with them and may they experience the companionship they need.
