8 Friday

Today, on *International Literacy Day*, we pray for all our volunteer letter writers and their penpals in prison.

9 Saturday

Today is the first day of training for new Sycamore Tree Group Facilitators. Thank God for all the amazing people committing to becoming Group Facilitators.

10 Sunday

Today is World Suicide Prevention Day. We continue to pray for anyone in prison who is experiencing suicidal ideation or who has been impacted by a death. God, bring Your comfort, love, and courage.

11 Monday

A *Sycamore Tree* course starts today at HMP High Down.

12 Tuesday

Pray for great connections at the Wales Group Leaders meeting tonight.

There are Sycamore Tree courses starting today at HMP Highpoint, HMP Leicester and HMP The Mount.

13 Wednesday

There are Sycamore Tree courses starting today at HMP Guys Marsh and HMP Springhill.

14 Thursday – Prayer Line request M is grateful for our prayers and feels they are helping. He asks for continued prayer that he would stay on the right path when he is released.

15 Friday

Our CEO, Peter Holloway, is away on holiday. Pray that he would have a restful and reenergising time.

As people in prison engage with this week's *Bible Study*, pray they would know that forgiveness is always found in God, and they might also be able to forgive themselves.

17 Sunday

Pray for people who have been released from prison this month. Ask God that they will find the

housing, work and support that they need to thrive and not return to prison. Pray that churches and Christians would reach out in welcome and companionship.

19 Tuesday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course starting today at HMP Stocken. Pray for all the learners beginning their journey today.

20 Wednesday

Over the course of a year, we are planning to pray for every prison in England and Wales. This month, we are praying for: Erlestoke, Exeter, Featherstone, Feltham YOI, Five Wells, Ford, Forest Bank, Foston Hall, Frankland and Full Sutton.

21 Thursday

We pray today for our Angel Tree Coordinators and their teams who are beginning to distribute application forms in prisons and are fundraising for the coming Christmas season.

22 Friday

Lift up to God everyone who has completed our *Pastoral Care* training. Thank God for them as they go into prisons and support people

experiencing loss and bereavement.

23 Saturday – Bible Study

This week's *Bible Study* is based on the parable of the workers in the vineyard. Ask God to bless everyone who reads it in prison and they would know His grace for themselves.

24 Sunday

Prisons Week 2023 is 8th – 14th October. Bring it before God in prayer. May more people learn about and feel called to pray for everyone affected by imprisonment.

25 Monday

Thank God for all our Area Coordinators who support our local groups. May they feel seen and appreciated for all they do to make volunteers feels welcome and included.

Jasks for prayer for herself and all the women struggling in prison. She asks for prayer particularly for her daughter, that she can make it through the coming year without her mother.

27 Wednesday

There are Sycamore Tree courses starting today at HMP Northumberland and HMP Styal.

28 Thursday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course ending today at HMP Berwyn.

29 Friday

Today is Hidden Heroes Day – an opportunity to thank God for those working in UK prisons, immigration removal centres, the probation service and youth justice services. They are often hidden to the world, but today we remember that their dedication and hard work is always seen by God.

30 Saturday

Intercede for everyone in prison still on imprisonment for public protection (IPP) sentences with no release date. In times of such uncertainty when all hope may seem lost, pray they would be given clarity and hope for the future.
