1 Friday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course ending at HMP Coldingley.

- 2 Saturday Bible Study
 This week's Bible Study
 encourages us to stay alert
 during the season of
 Advent. Pray that God
 would edify those in prison
 reading this today.
- 3 Sunday
 Today is the International
 Day of People with
 Disability. Remember those
 in prison who have a
 disability and pray that they
 would be able to access the
 resources they need.

4 Monday

There are *Sycamore Tree* courses ending at HMP Altcourse, HMP Pentonville and HMP Thorn Cross today.

5 Tuesday

Today, a subcommittee of our Trustees are meeting to discuss who might join them on the Board. Please pray for wisdom in their discussions.

6 Wednesday

The group that writes the Bible Studies each week are meeting to prepare them for January. Ask God for guidance as they put these vital resources together.

7 Thursday

Today the Support Team are meeting for a strategy day and Christmas lunch. Pray for a good time of fellowship.

There are *Sycamore Tree* courses ending at HMP Berwyn and HMP Rochester.

8 Friday

This week, Angel Tree
Coordinators across
England and Wales are
preparing to wrap and send
gifts on behalf of parents in
prison. Remember them in
your prayers and thank God
for their hard work and
dedication.

9 Saturday – Bible Study
This week, our Bible Study
asks people in prison to
identify situations in their
lives where they can reach
out and offer help. Ask for
clarity for anyone exploring
these themes.

10 Sunday – *Prayer Line* request

J asks for prayer for his spiritual journey. He prays for guidance and that he may fully experience a relationship with Jesus.

11 Monday

Pray for our CEO, Peter Holloway, as he visits HMP Woodhill and speaks with chaplains and the local group.

There is a *Sycamore Tree* course ending at HMP Brixton.

12 Tuesday

There is a Sycamore Tree course ending at HMP Onley. This is the last Sycamore Tree course of 2023. Thank God for His faithfulness.

13 Wednesday – *Prayer Line* request

A asks for prayer for his girlfriend who is also in prison. He asks that we pray for her protection and that she keeps strong.

14 Thursday

As part of Angel Tree, some parents in prison request that we send an ageappropriate Christian book to their child. Pray that these books will have a strong effect for good in the lives of the children they are sent to.

15 Friday

Our new Communications Officer, Rosie Orme, has started work with PF. Pray that she gels well with the team and can use her vision and creativity in this important work.

16 Saturday – Bible Study
This week, our Bible Study
looks at Gabriel's visit to
Mary in Luke 1. Pray that
the message of this Bible

Study would resonate with those that read it.

17 Sunday

Many people in prison feel incredibly isolated during the festive period. Ask that God would give them peace and comfort, especially anyone spending their first Christmas in prison.

18 Monday

Over the course of a year, we plan to pray for every prison in England and Wales. This month, we are praying for: Leeds, Leicester, Lewes, Leyhill, Lincoln, Lindholme, Littlehey, Liverpool, Long Lartin and Low Newton.

19 Tuesday

Remember prison staff who will be working over the Christmas period this year. Thank God for their commitment and ask that they would know His peace at Christmastime.

20 Wednesday – *Prayer Line* request

A asks for prayer for his Nan who is in hospital. He asks us to pray she gets through the next few weeks until he is released.

21 Thursday

The Prison Fellowship Carol Service will be available on YouTube at 11am. Pray for encouragement for all PF Volunteers and Supporters who join us.

22 Friday

The Support Office is closed for Christmas from today until 3rd January. Remember the staff team in your prayers and ask God that they would have a refreshing break.

- 23 Saturday Bible Study
 This week's Bible Study
 looks at Mary's visit to
 Elizabeth in Luke 1 and the
 promises fulfilled by God.
 Pray for anyone in prison
 who is waiting for God to
 fulfil a promise in their life.
- 24 Sunday Christmas Eve
 On this holy night, draw us
 into the mystery of your
 love. Be with those in prison
 tonight and bring them
 comfort.
- 25 Monday Christmas Day
 Lord, as we celebrate Your
 coming to the world as a
 baby, we pray especially for
 all children opening their
 Angel Tree presents today,
 that they may be truly

touched by the love of their parents who care about them so much.

Many children will have received a gift from their parent in prison this week. Pray that they will be nurtured in their relationships with their parents and carers.

27 Wednesday

Thank God for our amazing Angel Tree Coordinators who have sent thousands of Christmas presents to children with a parent in prison this year. Ask that God would fortify them as many of them prepare for Angel Tree Mother's Day in the New Year.

28 Thursday – *Prayer Line* request

A is experiencing difficult circumstances and requests prayer for help and peace so that he can get some

sleep. He also asks for prayer for court in January.

29 Friday

Remember prison Chaplains this week as they will have been leading a number of Christmas-related services. Ask that God would draw near to them and refresh them in this Christmas season.

- 30 Saturday Bible Study
 In Luke 2, we read about
 Simeon and Anna. Pray for
 people in prison reading
 this week's Bible Study. Ask
 that they would find hope
 and purpose in difficult
 situations.
- 31 Sunday New Year's Eve
 At the end of this year, we
 give thanks for God's
 faithfulness and lovingkindness, for sustaining and
 strengthening us
 throughout the year, and
 for His grace, which is
 offered freely to us all.
