13 Monday

There is a *Sycamore Tree* Tutor gathering today. Ask that God would be present during this time to guide, equip and strengthen all Tutors to continue their incredible work through *Sycamore Tree*.

14 Tuesday

During Mental Health Awareness week, please pray for the improvement of mental health care in prisons.

15 Wednesday

As we celebrate International Families Day, pray for all those in prison separated

from their families. Invite God to heal, restore and strengthen family ties where they have been broken. There is a *Sycamore Tree* course starting today at HMP Swaleside and one ending at HMP Send.

16 Thursday

The Board of Trustees are meeting today. Thank God for the commitment of our Board members and ask that He would give them wisdom in their decision making.

17 Friday

There is a Baptist conference in Telford over the next two days where we have a stand to promote PF's work. Pray that through this, more Volunteers would step forward to become part of our ministry.

18 Saturday – Bible Study

This week's *Bible Study* explores how the Holy Spirit

is our Comforter and our Helper, especially when we don't know what to pray. Lift to God all those struggling to pray asking that they would be comforted by the Holy Spirit.
