May they know His love and purpose for their lives.	27	Thursday - PF Groups We lift up PF Feltham and PF East Sutton Park and the prisons they serve. We pray that they would be filled with the Holy Spirit today and always.
21	Friday - Prayer Line request M asks for prayer for his forthcoming parole hearing. He prays for a good outcome. He also prays for his deteriorating health and wellbeing.	28	Friday We give thanks for the amazing work of our Head of Volunteer Engagement, Andrew Hulley, and pray for him in his new ministry.
22	Saturday - Bible Studies Today, as we think about the story of the fig tree bearing fruit, we bring to mind the many people in prison who are bearing fruit because of their faith. Let's bring to mind the image of the father joyfully welcoming the son home and forgiving everything he has done, and hold it in our hearts as we pray for people in prison reading the story.

May they truly feel part of the family of God today.	30	Sunday - Chaplains and Chaplaincy Teams On Mother's Day we pray especially for those who are away from home for the first time. We pray for renewed, healthy relationships with parents and caregivers. We also pray for mothers in prison, that they would know comfort and peace today.
24	Monday - Prayer Line request R asks for prayer as he is in a dark place at the moment. He is especially struggling with his cell mate. We pray for a resolution to the situation.	31	Monday – Prayer Line request F asks for prayer for her upcoming court appearance, that the judge would give her a suspended sentence. This would stop her daughter being adopted. She prays she would be delivered from the pit she feels she is in. We also hold Week 6 of <i>Sycamore Tree</i> at HMP Fosse Way in prayer.
25	Tuesday – Living with Loss As Mother's Day approaches, we pray for people doing the <i>LWL</i> course who have lost mothers and other significant caregivers. We pray for comfort and learning to grieve in a way that doesn't cause harm to themselves or those around them.
