

Prayer Diary – February 2026



'Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?'

1	Sunday – Bible Studies We are reminded that our God is 'strong and mighty' in this week's Bible Study. Ask that those studying God's Word would come to know His glory and love.	9	Monday Children's Mental Health Week begins today. We pray for children who have parents in prison. Ask God for increased awareness of the effects of parental imprisonment and for more support to be put in place.
2	Monday We are holding <i>Letter Link</i> training today. Please pray for those stepping into this role. Ask that God would equip them with compassion and understanding as they begin to write to people in prison.	10	Tuesday We have a volunteer training event today. Thank God for our new volunteers and ask that this time of learning would be fruitful and productive.
3	Tuesday We are currently seeking a Head of Volunteer and Church Engagement to join our staff team. Please pray that God would call someone into this role and for a smooth recruitment process.	11	Wednesday – PF Groups Today, we lift up PF Bridgend and PF Brixton. Thank God for those who lead these groups and pray that they would continue to serve their local prisons with compassion.
4	Wednesday On World Cancer Day, we remember people in prison facing illnesses. Invite God into their pain – praying for healing and strength in mind, body and soul.	12	Thursday – Prayer Line T wants to thank God for the Chaplain in his prison who has been running Bible study groups. He expresses gratitude and states that many in his prison have been helped by the chaplaincy team.
5	Thursday – Prayer Line R asks for forgiveness for his previous actions. We pray for all those in prison who are battling with their past. Ask God to meet them in their hurt and reveal His forgiving love to them.	13	Friday During the shortest month, we pray for those serving short sentences. Ask that they would receive support upon their release to help address offending behaviour and make positive changes in their lives.
6	Friday As preparation for <i>Angel Tree Mother's Day</i> continues, we ask our faithful God to oversee every part of this programme. Pray for a fruitful harvest of hope and restored relationships between young adults in prison and their mums this year.	14	Saturday – Bible Studies This week, we explore the Transfiguration of Jesus – a mountaintop moment for His disciples! Ask that people in prison who are exploring faith would experience their own 'mountaintop moments' as they encounter Jesus.
7	Saturday – Bible Studies This week's Bible study reminds us of the importance of prayer. Pray that people in prison would be refreshed and strengthened through spending time with God.	15	Sunday – Chapels and chaplaincy teams Today, we pray for every chapel service taking place in prisons across England and Wales. May God's presence fill every room and every heart, as His name is lifted high
8	Sunday – Churches Today, we thank God for the churches which support prison ministry. We pray that He would bless them for their faithful servant hearts and guide them in their outreach work.	16	Monday This month, we are launching a second phase pilot of our new restoration course. We lift up the prisons taking part, asking for God's guidance and wisdom in the development of this new programme.

17	Tuesday Today is Random Acts of Kindness Day. We ask God to show us what we can do today to share His love and kindness with people in prison.	23	Monday Our <i>Bible Studies</i> writing group is meeting this evening. We ask God to lead them as they create these valuable resources that bring God's Word to those in prison.
18	Wednesday – Ash Wednesday As we enter Lent, the season of waiting, we remember those waiting in prison. Pray that they may find strength and patience through the long days. And ask that they may share in the same hope we have—the hope of the resurrection.	24	Tuesday – Prisons Over the course of a year, we will be praying for every prison in England and Wales. This month, we pray for HMP Cardiff, HMP Channings Wood, HMP Chelmsford, HMP Coldingley and HMP Cookham Wood.
19	Thursday – Prayer Line C has called twice in distress, asking for prayer. Lift C to God, praying that He will meet her in her difficulty and provide all she needs at this time.	25	Wednesday – PF Groups Today, we thank God for PF Bronzefield and PF Cambridge. Ask God to bless these groups and their work, as they continue to serve in and pray for their local prisons.
20	Friday Today, we pray for our work on the Isle of Wight. We ask God to raise up more volunteers so we can establish a prayer group and expand our ministry in the island's prisons.	26	Thursday This morning, Bishop Rachel Treweek will be joining us for our online <i>National Prayer Gathering</i> . Please pray for a fruitful time of fellowship, worship and prayer for prisons.
21	Saturday – Bible Studies In this week's Bible study, we read about the beginning of Jesus' ministry. Pray that people in prison would know they too have a place to serve in the Kingdom of God.	27	Friday – Prayer Line R wants to give thanks for his recent baptism and the blessings he has received. Thank God for R and his journey of faith. Pray that R would share his testimony to inspire others in prison to explore faith.
22	Sunday – Chapels and chaplaincy teams We pray today for all those speaking in prison chapels across England and Wales. Ask that God would speak through them, sharing His light and goodness with all those who hear.	28	Saturday – Bible Studies This week, we read about Jesus' temptation in the wilderness. Ask God to help people in prison when they face temptations in their own 'wilderness seasons.'
